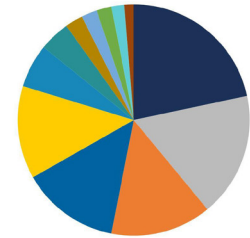

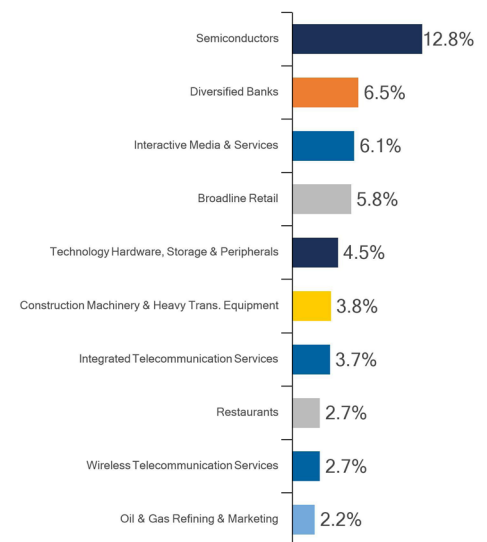
GICS Sector Breakdown¹
